## 1. DATA CONTROLLER

## 2. PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

## 5. RECIPIENTS AND INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

The personal data collected will not be sold, rented or transferred to third-party companies. To ensure the technical functioning of the website, support is provided by the following service providers under their respective privacy guidelines:

## 6. USER RIGHTS

The user has the right to access their personal data, request the rectification of inaccurate data, or request its erasure when the data is no longer necessary. The user may also request the restriction of, or object to, the processing of their data.
